Adoption of Mir Behri Saidakadal in the interiors of Dal Lake Area in 2012-13 onwards

The Directorate of Lifelong Learning (DLL) has been on the forefront in the overall development of the unreached and deprived locales which entail the urban status, but when looked from the prismatic point of view of development, they hardly score anything. DLL in one such model adopted an area of Saida Kadal(Mir Behri) few Kilometres away from the University campus under the scheme of Area Based Community Development(ABCD) approach of UGC, New Delhi.In the initial phase of the programme, a skill school was thrown open for the youth of the particular area, where they learnt various skill based courses and earned a certification in the respective skill trades. Also getting other basic amenities related to health, education, counseling together with the awareness generation and capacity building programmes.The step has been lauded by all walks of life.
